

The figures for 1, 2, 3, 6 and 8 were created from the Questionnaire asked to the public.




The Friends of Saintbridge Pond are considerate of effects to nature and waste in every activity undertaken, which is shown by habitat diversity.



Overall, Saintbridge Pond measures well against the criteria, with the public viewing the site as welcoming, clean and safe, and showing concern for the future of the site. The future of Saintbridge Pond will be considering the sustainability, conservation, with aims to increase inclusion and monitor work undertaken.

Marketing of the site is split into technological, paper and on site methods, and these will be utilised in the three events proposed for Saintbridge Pond.

Future management of the site will more prominently consider the public view (See Below) when prioritising work
